

Charlbury Town Council – proposed Neighbourhood Plan Submission to West Oxfordshire District Council

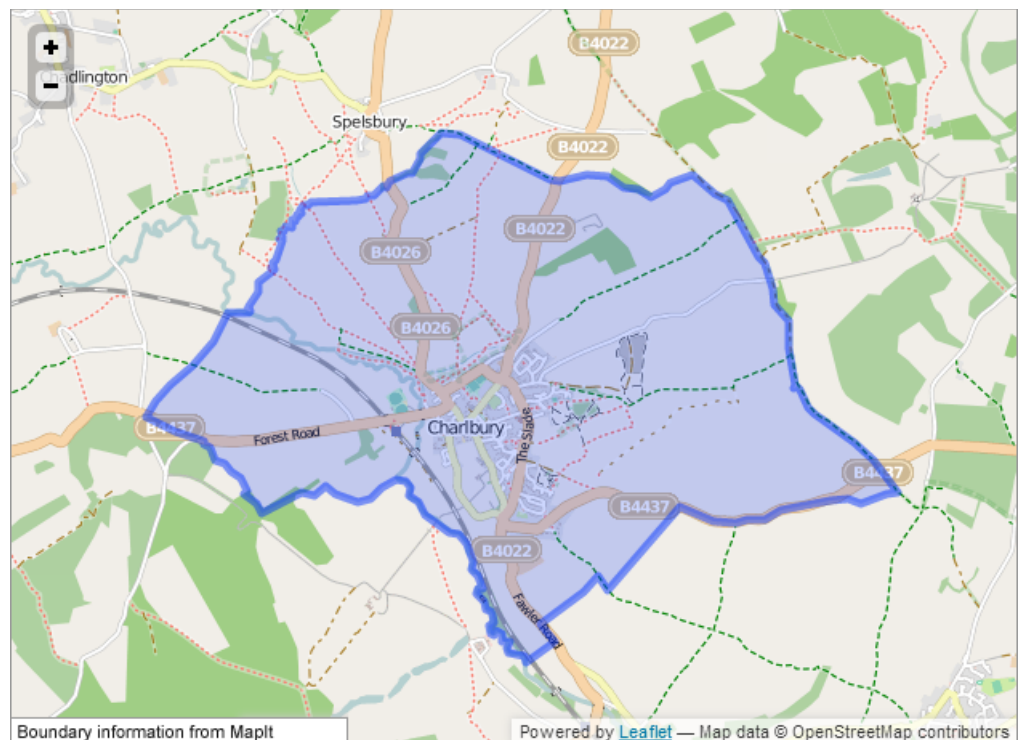
Application to West Oxfordshire District Council for the Designation of the Charlbury Neighbourhood Plan Area for the purposes of producing the Charlbury Neighbourhood Plan

Following extensive public consultation and research over the last eighteen months, Charlbury Town Council are in agreement with conclusions of Charlbury Community-Led Plan Advisory Group (now re-named Charlbury Neighbourhood Plan Action Group [CNPAG]) that a Neighbourhood Plan would serve the best interests of the community of Charlbury in the coming years.

Proposed Neighbourhood Plan Area

We submit that the area covered by the proposed plan should be the established parish of Charlbury. The proposed area, in addition to conforming to the existing parish boundary, also reflects the physical, social and economic integrity of the Town of Charlbury.

We confirm that under amendment to the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (Section 61G) Charlbury Town Council is the “relevant” (qualifying) body which may submit an application to the Local Planning Authority (WODC) for designation of a Neighbourhood Area for Charlbury.
