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I am writing to comment on the draft Stonesfield Neighbourhood Plan which I **strongly** support. The plan clearly reflects the overwhelming support of actual Stonesfield residents.

This includes a strong view that it is critical to Stonesfield that all local green spaces outlined in APPENDIX C need to remain local green spaces to remain a Cotswold village, and not be developed further to the detriment of those living in the village for just personal financial windfall benefit of a small number of ex-residents, some of whom have left the village. Given the current housing stock and profile there is zero justification or need for Stonesfield residents to add to the oversupply of large expensive housing with additional on congestion and bus obstruction through a large increase in on-street parking, particularly along Combe Road. Stonesfield has very limited public transport so the very worst location for more development.

Oxfordshire should only build additional incremental development on existing brownfield land convenient to public transport hubs only. Any housing in small villages must be limited to small low income only, and should never be used as an excuse for more high impact large expensive housing that the village has zero need for.
