TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT

ORDER, 1950.

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT
(STANTON HARCOURT)) DIRECTION, 1952.

W H E R E A S the Council of the Administrative County of Oxford being the local planning authority for the said County of Oxford are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions specified in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on the land in the Parish of Stanton Harcourt in the County of Oxford shown coloured pink on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950.

NOW THEREFORE the Said Council of the Administrative County of Oxford in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto.

This Direction may be cited as the "Oxfordshire County Council (Permitted Development (Stanton Harcourt)) Direction, 1952."

THE SCHEDULE ABOVE REFERRED TO

Development of Class IV specified in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, where such development comprises the use of any land for the purpose of motor car or motor cycle racing pacing or trials or any other similar use. Given under the Common Seal of the Oxfordshire County Council this fourth day of April One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.


