TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 & 1968

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1963

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT  
(CASSINGTON)) DIRECTION, 1970

W H E R E A S the Council of the Administrative County of Oxford (hereinafter called "the Council") being the local planning authority for the said County are satisfied that it is expedient that the development referred to in the Schedule hereto being development of Class XXII - Use as Caravan Site specified in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963 (hereinafter called "the Order") should not be carried out on the land in the Parish of Cassington in the said County shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto (hereinafter called "the land") unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf \_\_\_\_\_

N O W T H E R E F O R E the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Order hereby directs that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to the development referred to in the Schedule hereto being development of Class XXII specified in the First Schedule to the Order on the land \_\_\_\_\_

This Direction may be cited as the "Oxfordshire County Council (Permitted Development (Cassington)) Direction, 1970" \_\_\_\_\_

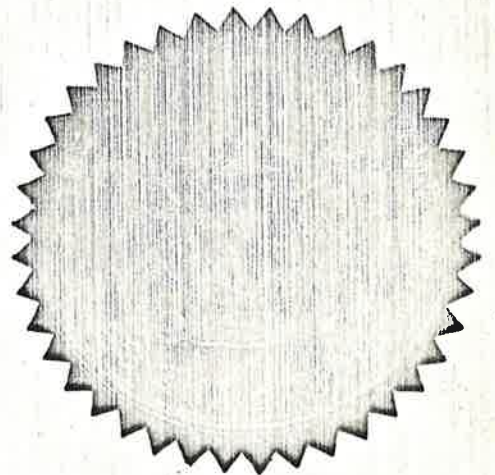

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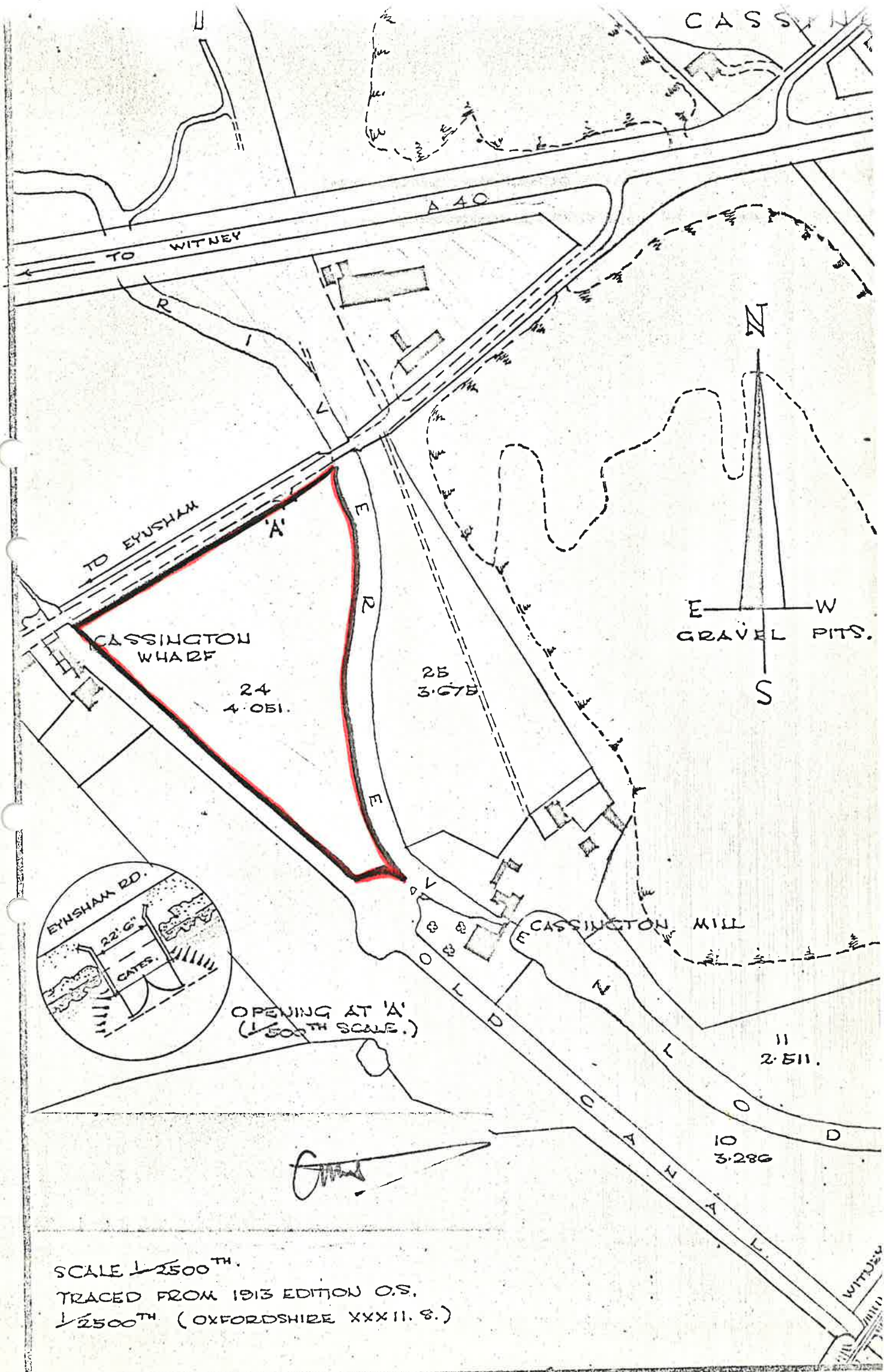
