TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1950.

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT (SHIPTON-UNDER-WYCHWOOD)) DIRECTION, 1960

WHEREAS the Council of the Administrative County of Oxford being the local planning authority for the said County of Oxford are satisfied that it is expedient that development of Class VI(1) specified in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, which comprises the erection of a building or buildings for the purpose of the breeding, rearing, keeping or housing of pigs, should not be carried out in the area in the Parish of Shipton-under-Wychwood shown coloured pink on the plan annexed hereto unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

NOW THEREFORE the said Council of the Administrative
County of Oxford in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article
4 of the said Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950,
hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order
shall not apply to development of Class VI(1) specified in the First
Schedule to the said Order which comprises the erection of a building or
buildings for the purpose of the breeding, rearing, keeping or housing of
pigs in the said area in the said Parish of Shipton-under-Wychwood in the
County of Oxford

This Direction may be cited as the "Oxfordshire County Council (Permitted Development (Shipton-under-Wychwood)) Direction, 1960"_____


