**Your attention is drawn to the following:**

**Part 11 of the Gambling Act 2005 which describes offences including:**

**Section 262 of the Act – Small Society Lottery: Breach of Condition**

**A non-commercial society commits and offence if –**

- a) a lottery, purporting to be an exempt lottery under Part 4 of Schedule 11, is promoted on the society's behalf wholly or partly at a time when the Society is not registered with a local authority in accordance with Part 5 of the that Schedule.
- b) the society fails to comply with the requirements of Paragraph 39 of that Schedule, or
- c) the Society provides false or misleading information for the purposes of Paragraph 39 of the Schedule.

**The Penalty under Section 263 of the Act:**

A person guilty of an offence under this part shall be liable on summary conviction to:

- a) imprisonment for a term not exceeding 51 weeks,
- b) a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or
- c) both.
